Cost of Poor Material Quality: Poor Material Quality has significant impacts on project cost through all phases of Design, Construction and Commissioning eventually shifting over to Operating budgets. Preventing quality issues early-on in a project through proactive and preventive measures assures the highest quality and lowest lifecycle cost. Quality can't be inspected into a project only planned in.

Guest Speaker: Bill Forbes is currently Senior Manager for Enbridge's Major Project group located in their Edmonton, Alberta office and is responsible for overall Quality of Major Projects. A Professional engineer with over 30 years' experience in the Design Construction and Operation of pipelines and pipeline facilities

Bill completed a bachelor's degree in Mechanical Engineering at the University of Saskatchewan in Saskatoon. Upon graduation worked for SaskEnergy joined Nova Gas Transmission in 1988 as a senior pipeline project engineer just prior to the extensive capital program expansion. Held extensive leadership positions within NOVA / TCPL / Enbridge, and at one point accountable for the project management of all Capital Projects within Nova involving pipelines from NPS-16 to NPS-48 and all Compressor Stations. Within Enbridge Bill led the Canadian portion of the Alberta Clipper, Southern Lights and Line 4 extension projects from preliminary development through to the submittal of the NEB application (\$2.6 billion project). In addition Bill was instrumental in creating the initial "Contingency" and "Escalation" models that are currently being utilized Enbridge wide for Major Projects.
