The interactive course highlights the significant changes to the standard and discusses how to manage these changes in your Quality Management System (QMS), including the benefits of the changes, options of how to implement them, the documentation requirements and the transition steps needed to upgrade your QMS to ISO 9001:2015.

- Have a greater understanding of the structure, key changes, and intent of the ISO 9001:2015 requirements
